### Requirements for submission:

1. Student papers must be approved for the SIEPR Discussion Paper Series by a Stanford faculty member. This is to ensure sufficiently high quality.
2. Papers must be policy relevant.
3. Papers must contain an abstract.
4. Papers should be submitted in hard copy and electronic format to Greg Rosston and should be accompanied by a note from the faculty member noting approval for publication.
